Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be presented to top three finishers in each category as follows:

Cub A and B: 1440 Round, Individual, Team and Mixed Team Rounds.

Cadet A and B: 72 arrows, Individual, Team and Mixed Team Rounds.

Junior: 72 arrows, Individual, Team and Mixed Team Rounds.

Senior: 72 arrows, Individual, Team and Mixed Team Rounds.

Master: 72 arrows, Individual, Teams and Mixed Team Rounds.

Para WW1, MW1, RMO, RWO, CMO, CWO: 72 arrows, Individual, Teams and Mixed Team Rounds.

The winners of the Individual Olympic Round will be considered as Champions of the 2018 Mexican Grand Prix.

## **UNIFORM**

In compliance with the World Archery Rules. It must be worn with the archer's name in the back of the shirts, and the country's acronym or full name. This uniform must be worn from the day of official practice.

## **PRELIMINARY AND FINAL REGISTRATION**

All registration must be made using the World Archery Online Registration System (WAREOS) <http://register.worldarchery.org>. No entry forms will be accepted for registering to this event if they are not made with WAREOS.

There is no limit in the number of individual entries per category in any of the events. All preliminary and final registrations need to be made using WAREOS.

For the team events, each country must submit a maximum of 4 names in each category at the Team Managers' Meeting.

Final registrations made after the deadline will cause the member association involved to pay a 50.00 USD penalty per archer to the Local Organizing Committee upon arrival in Cancun.

Final registrations made without having made preliminary registration will cause the member association involved to pay a 150.00 USD penalty to the Local Organizing Committee upon arrival in Cancun.

### Cancelations and changes

Cancelations must be requested in writing and be submitted to the Local Organizing Committee before February 28 to be able to receive full reimbursement. Reimbursements will be handled by the Organizers after March 3. Cancelations requested after February 28 will not be reimbursed. A name change (in the same category) will be accepted up to 72 hours before the start of the competition without an additional charge. arrival date they had indicated in their accommodation booking form will still need to cover accommodation costs as per in the original reservation made by the Member Association involved.

### ***VISAS***

If your team requires visas to travel to Mexico, it is important that you start the visa application process as soon as possible. Your national Federation must submit the visa application forms at the Mexican Consulate in your country as early as possible so that the visas are issued before your team travels to Cancun.

Visa application is the responsibility of the participating teams and their national federations. The process requires each individual intending to travel to Mexico to submit an application at a Mexican Embassy or Consulate.

This is a process that needs to be completed by each individual participant. The Local Organizing Committee cannot do it on their behalf.

For updated information on the requisites to apply for a Mexican Visa, please contact the Mexican Embassy or Consulate in your country.
