If the applicant does not hold these professional designations, they will not be accepted into the seminar. Application forms attached must be completed in full and submitted by the national federation representing the participant. All expenses are covered by attendants or their national federations. Application should be sent by national federation. **THIS SEMINAR MUST BE ATTENDED IN PERSON.** There will be no virtual option.

As a part of preparation for this event, the representative of World Archery office Ms. Cecilia Viscarra will ask you for your cooperation in advising her of your travel arrangements for your trip to Dubai, UAE.

Please note that there must be a minimum of 5 participants in attendance to proceed with this seminar training.
